





Scan for Authorized Movers

<u>M</u>ake sure you agree up front on the moving date, costs, and packing details. Authorized movers may negotiate rates based on a Maximum Rate Tariff established by the NC Utilities Commission (NCUC).

<u>Organize</u> and plan ahead. Obtain copies of all signed and completed documents with the company's name, address, phone number, and NCUC certificate number noted.

<u>V</u>alue your possessions properly. Ask your mover to explain the two types of valuation protection offered. Settlement of any claims depends on the valuation you select.

<u>E</u>nsure your mover is authorized to perform your move by checking the list of authorized movers at http://www.ncuc.net/consumer/carriers.pdf.

Insurance is required by the NCUC for all authorized movers. Unauthorized movers may not be properly insured, so you may not be reimbursed for damages or loss.
